Attendance, punctuality and illness

Also in line with Local Authority procedures we will be sending letters of concern to parents of pupils with an attendance of less than 90% during the Autumn term. We appreciate that the vast majority of absences are unavoidable through illness and ask that if you have any questions or queries about the letters that you receive, that you contact me to discuss further.

Could I also politely remind you that registration begins at 8.55a.m. and we would request that all pupils arrive in school between 8.45a.m. and 8.55a.m. please. Late arrivals do disrupt the start of the day for staff and pupils.

Watches

It has been brought to our attention that some pupils are wearing watches to school that have the capability to take photographs, send messages and access the internet. While these are, I'm sure, fun for our pupils, it does raise safeguarding concerns for us at school and we have already had instances where photographs of other pupils have been taken. I'm sure you will understand that on this basis we request that these watches are kept a home and not worn to school in future please.

Focus week

Next week will be our second focus week of the year and children across the school will be studying animals and issues that are related including ecology. The week will begin with our visit to Chester Zoo and all work for the remainder of the week will follow on from the visit. We are sure that this will be a valuable experience for all our pupils.

Building update

After a short delay, the removal of tiles from the roof is due to begin today. Class 2 have settled well into their new classroom and Class 1 will have an area partitioned for the time being while the first stage of the work is being completed. We are aware that collection at the end of the day is difficult due to the number of parents and pupils at the back gate.
