Inspection report

Last week we shared with you our Estyn inspection report. We are extremely please with the outcome of the inspection and I would like to thank all Staff and Governors for their hard work and dedication to the school. Can I also thank all parents who completed the pre inspection questionnaire or attended the inspection meeting, your input was extremely helpful. Most of all, we are very proud of the children who are praised throughout the report for their attitude, behaviour and hard work which is richly deserved. Entrance and pick up points

The following arrangements are in place for drop off and collection for each class this year.

All gates will be opened by 8.45a.m. with school starting at 8.55a.m.

Gates will be locked soon after these times so if you are late, please come to the main front entrance. Collection will be from the same points at the end of the school day at 3.15p.m.

School uniform

Thank you for supporting our policy of children wearing school uniform each day.

Children should wear a white polo shirt, royal blue jumper, fleece or cardigan and black or grey trousers or skirt to school with black shoes.

Branded uniform is available from Constructiv clothing through their website and we hold a small amount of uniform at school. Friends of the school also have second hand uniform for sale which is a great way of saving money.

We are acutely aware of the financial pressures on families currently and that school uniform has been high on the news agenda recently. As a school, can I reassure you that there is no pressure on

pupils wearing the branded uniform and we are happy for children to wear plain uniform in the correct colours that are available from supermarkets as an alternative.

After School and Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club is available to all pupils for a cost of £1 per day. The club starts at 8.10a.m.

Our after school club, The Later Lambs, continues to grow in numbers and is available 5 days a week for £7 per child. The club runs from the end of the school day until 5.14p.m.
